| Measure Collection   | Collection Method         | Frequency  | Beneficiaries |
|--|---------------------------|------------|---------------|
| Number of communities reporting decrease in cases of disease(s) targeted | Grant records and Reports | Every week | 2500+         |
| Number of medical and health professionals trained                       | Grant records and Reports | Every week | 1-19          |
| Number of health-focused events  | Grant records and Reports | Every week | 100-499       |
| Number of health facilities benefiting                                   | Grant records and Reports | Every week | 1-19          |

# Rotary



## Funding

- The funding is made up of:
  - i. District Designated Fund (DDF) will be matched 100% by the Rotary World Fund; and
  - ii. Cash Contribution (no 50% match from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020).
- Funds and project budget must balance.

- Download the '*Global Grant Record*'.
- Submitting the application will trigger an automated authorisation requests to:
  - i. District Governor
  - ii. District Rotary Foundation Chair
  - iii. International Primary Contact
  - iv. Host Primary Contact
